

Speed Skate Nova Scotia 2010/11 AGM Director of Competitions Report

2010/2011 Season

During the 2010/11 season the Dartmouth Speed Skating Club was the host club for the Canada Winter Games during week one of the games. St. Margaret's centre hosted the Short Track event and Long Track occurred on the Canada Games Oval built on the Halifax Commons.

On January 8 and 9, 2011, Dartmouth Speed Skating Club and Halifax Regional Municipality hosted "Skate the Common Marathon". There were close to 300 participants.

The Canadian Masters Championships and Halifax 2011 Canada Games Invitational Test Event (Long Track) was held January 15 - 16, 2011 and served as the test event for the Canada Winter Games. The Dartmouth Speed Skating Club was the host club and financial support was provided by the Department of Health and Wellness, Speed Skating Canada and the Canada Games Host Society.

National/International Competition Participation

Canadian Championships Neo Senior Junior A & B, Montreal, March 17 – 20, 2011

Jillian MacDonald and Elisabeth-Anne Roy represented Nova Scotia. Elisabeth-Anne Roy placed 9th overall in the Junior B Division and with a 5th place finish in the individual 1500m distance. She achieved personal best times in both her 500m and 1000m distances. Jillian MacDonald placed 12th overall in the Neo Senior Junior A Division. She achieved personal best times in her 500m and 1000m times as well.

20th Masters International Speed Skating Allround Games, Calgary, Feb 24 -27, 2011

Sheila McGinn and Henk Kwindt attended and finished 3rd and 6th respectively.
