



Nova Scotia Canada Games Arrival/Departure Information

Team Arrival at Games:

Week 1 Date: Thursday, February 10, 2011

Arrival: All members of Team NS should arrive at 6:15pm

Location: Woodside Ferry Terminal
Atlantic Street, Dartmouth

Directions: Take Circumferential Highway to the end. Turn right on Pleasant Street. Turn left on Atlantic Street (350m). Ferry Terminal Entrance is on right hand side (past the entrance to the Park and Ride parking lot).

Week 2 Date: Saturday, February 19, 2011

Arrival: All members of Team NS should arrive at 6:15pm

Location: Woodside Ferry Terminal
Atlantic Street, Dartmouth

Directions: Take Circumferential Highway to the end. Turn right on Pleasant Street. Turn left on Atlantic Street (350m). Ferry Terminal Entrance is on right hand side (past the entrance to the Park and Ride parking lot).

Loading of Ferry (arrival):

- Parents will drop off athletes at the entrance to the Woodside Ferry Terminal
- Athletes will proceed to lower level of the Ferry Terminal to meet their team
- Team Manager/Coach will gather their team
- Teams will not be permitted to board the ferry until Team Manager/Coach has indicated the entire team present

Equipment:

- Please have equipment on-site by 6:15pm for loading into equipment vans
- Team NS equipment tags, already provided to Team Manager/Coach, must be attached to each equipment bag
- Equipment will be transported by the Canada Games Host Society to the appropriate equipment storage

Travel Uniform (mandatory):

- Team NS parka
- Team NS long sleeve shirt (grey)
- Team NS track pants

Personal Luggage:

- Athletes, artists, coaches, managers and other coaching staff are restricted to one (1) suitcase and one (1) carry on bag (Team NS kit bag)
- The Team NS Athletes Village luggage tag, already provided to Team Manager/Coach, must be attached to the suitcase



Team Departure from Games:

Week 1 Date: Saturday, February 19, 2011

Time: Team NS will arrive by bus at the Civic Arena parking lot at 9:45am

Location: Civic Arena parking lot
2901 Windsor Street, Halifax (corner of Windsor Street and Young Street)

Directions: From Northern NS and Cape Breton, take highway 102 to Highway 118 into Halifax. Take Circumferential Highway to go to MacKay Bridge and continue on to Windsor Street.
From South Shore, take Highway 103 into Halifax. Take exit 1B onto Bayers Road. Stay on Bayers Road until it meets with Windsor Street.
From Annapolis Valley, take Highway 101 and merge onto Bicentennial Highway. Take exit 1B onto Bayers Road. Stay on Bayers Road until it meets with Windsor Street.

Notes: Departure times will vary depending on the plans of the Canada Games Host Society. Any departures will be communicated to Team Manager/Coach as soon as possible during the games.

Week 2 Date: Sunday, February 27, 2011

Time: Team NS will arrive by bus at 4:30pm

Location: Stadacona Drill Shed, Fleet Club
2800 Barrington Street, Halifax

Notes: Departure times will vary depending on the plans of the Canada Games Host Society. Any departures will be communicated to Team Manager/Coach as soon as possible during the games.

General Information:

- Please let your Mission Staff know as soon as possible of any Team NS members who are not comfortable travelling over water by ferry. There ferry ride to downtown Halifax will be approximately 12-15 minutes.
- Athletes will have access to the dining hall once they arrive in Halifax and have checked into their rooms.
- We will walk from the Halifax Ferry Terminal to our accommodations in Athletes Village using the pedway system.
- The ferry ride will be restricted to Team NS members and invited guests.
